Eligibility

Malaysian IABC members in good standing, based in Malaysia, are eligible for nomination. Board nominations are self-nominated.

Timeframe

The nomination period is currently open and all applications must be received by email by **5pm Wednesday, 28th April 2021**.

Criteria

A number of **criteria** will be taken into consideration when evaluating nominations, including:

- A strong service ethic; this is a working board, not an honorary role. Applicants should be skilled at both delivery and leading through others.
- Strong team player – a board must build rapport quickly and be adept at working well together
- Strategic thinkers who are also keen to roll up their sleeves
- History of achievement and delivering on commitments, as demonstrated through this application, CV, and referee checks
- All board members should be of good character, have the genuine interest of IABC members at heart & commit to uphold the [IABC Code of Ethics](#)

Duties of IABC Malaysia Board members

Requirements – what's expected of the board

- The board will meet by video conference call monthly
 - Board members absent from three meetings may be asked to resign.
- Board members should allocate an average of approximately **5 hours per month** for chapter work.
- Participation in the AGM and any other member meetings required.
